VECTOR BORNE DISEASES

Vector borne diseases are diseases transmitted to humans from arthropods like ticks and mosquitoes. There are several vector borne diseases transmitted in Massachusetts.

<u>Ticks</u>



-Lyme Disease -Babesiosis -Anaplasmosis

Mosquitoes

-Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) -West Nile Virus



PROTECT YOURSELF FROM TICKS AND MOSQUITOES

1. Wear **insect repellent** with DEET or permethrin



2. Wear long pants and long sleeve shirts

3. Take extra precaution at **dawn and dusk**, when mosquitoes are most active

4. Check yourself for ticks when you come inside

5. Remove **stagnant pools of water**mosquitoes breed here!



6. Tell your doctor if you **feel sick** or have a **"bulls-eye" rash**
